


Standard Bins for LC503TYL1-30Q-A1 ($I_F = 20 \text{ mA}$)

All luminous intensity (I_v) and dominant wavelength (λ_D) values shown and specified are at $I_F = 20$ mA.




Important Notes:

- 5. Tolerance of measurement of V_F is ± 0.05 V.








FIG.2 REVERSE CURRENT VS. REVERSE VOLTAGE.












Mechanical Dimensions

Burr around bottom of epoxy may be 0.5 mm max.


Users should be cautioned not to stare at the light of this LED product. The bright light can damage the eye.
